Family Promise

Family Promise helps homeless families with children. They provide intensive case management and access to services that help them regain housing, self-sufficiency & temporary housing. Pastor's Goodwill Fund

Ocean City has a number of people living on the financial edge. The pastors at St. Peters counsel citizens, church members, and those in need. This fund provides support for medical needs, food and necessities. At the pastor's discretion this fund has been used to support existing programs within the church that provide help to people in need.

Adopt a Cuba Pastor

Cuba has more than 400 Methodist Churches. With extreme poverty only about half of these churches can afford to pay their pastor a salary; generally \$30 per month. St. Peter's sponsors 10 pastors by paying their monthly salary.

In 2024 St. Peter's adopted a small rural church in Cuba. La Italiana is a small village in the east of Cuba. The church is very small with 15 members and 30 children. Our financial support provides a meal after worship each Sunday and a small stipend for the pastor.

Dominican Republic Mission

The DR Mission began at St. Peter's 16 years ago and now includes several other churches. Teams build homes, share the Gospel, sponsor students to go to better schools and to English classes. The new Community Center in Los Cocos gives residents a chance at a better life with English language classes and a library. Donations this year will help us build another house when a team returns in April 2025.
